#### **The Danielsville Guards**

This company, Capt John M Montgomery, left this place yesterday for Richmond. This completes Gov Cobb's Regiment. – We will publish a list of the company next week. The company is composed of the [best] material.

#### **Paoli, Madison co., Ga, July 24th**

At a meeting of a very large and respectable portion of the citizens of this place, George Eberhart, Esq., was called to the chair, and Dr H S Bradley requested to act as Secretary. On motion, the meeting was opened by an eloquent and fervent prayer, from the Rev R W Milner. On motion, the Chairman then appointed R W Milner, Asa Deadwyler and Jesse Power a committee to prepare business for the meeting.

While the committee were out, Rev James Rowe was called upon and made an encouraging speech. The committee then returned and made the following report of resolutions, supported by a few eloquent remarks, from the Chairman of said committee:

In times of such eminent peril as now have fallen upon our country, it is required of every good citizen that he stand by it with our all. An unscrupulous foe of vast resources, is now devastating our borders slaughtering our sons and brothers, determined to enslave us and our children. In view of these things, Resolved.

1<sup>st</sup>. That we pledge ourselves to the support of our government in every way as far as our ability extends.

2d. That we will most cheerfal's [sic] give our support to any measure that may be devised by our country, for the support and equipment of our volunteers.

3d. That we highly approve of the course adopted by our Inferior Court, to devise means to support the needy families of our volunteers, during their absence, and we will join our fellow citizens in seeing this done to the full amount needed.

4<sup>th</sup>. That we request the female members of our families to form themselves into an association, for the purpose of aiding with clothing and other things needful for the comfort of our volunteers.

5<sup>th</sup>. That we take the names of those persons who are willing to aid in any way for the equipment of volunteers, and the support of their families. These resolutions were then unanimously adopted.

In accordance with the above, the Chairman appointed the following persons a committee, to take the names of those who are willing to contribute in any way.

Dr J F Grover, George Eberhart, Jesse Power, Rob't Woods, Asa Deadwyler, Peter David and Jas Long.

A committee was then appointed to take the names of all the ladies present, who were willing to help in any way, when they unanimously came forward and offered their services, to knit or sew for the volunteers.

H F Sanders then moved that these proceedings be published in the Athens papers, which was carried.

The meeting then adjourned.

#### **Our Army Correspondence**

Yorktown Va., Set 19<sup>th</sup>, 1861

Mr Christy: - I have concluded, with your permission, to trouble your numerous readers with a few lines, to let the friends of the Mell Volunteers know where our company has been placed. We had a very pleasant trip from Athens to this place. We arrived at Augusta at 7, P.M. (the 5<sup>th</sup> of Sept.) and were marched to the South Carolina depot, where the ladies of Augusta had a very nice supper provided for us. It was very encouraging to a company of soldiers, to be furnished with such a nice supper, and it attended by the beautiful ladies of Augusta. At 8 o'clock we left Augusta and arrived at

Columbia, S.C. at 5, A.M., Friday, and at 8 o'clock we left for Charlotte, N.C., where we arrived at 3, P.M. Here we laid over for about 7 hours. The citizens of Charlotte had an excellent supper provided for us at the Mansion Hotel, which was very acceptable to the members of our company. At 10, P.M. we were on our way to Raleigh, where we arrived at 6, A.M. Saturday. Here we overtook Capt. Vincent's company and travelled with them to Weldon, where we separated. We left Weldon as soon as we could change cars, and we arrived at Petersburg at 7, P.M, and were directed to the lawn, where the citizens have erected a very large and comfortable house for the benefit of the soldiers passing through.

Here we laid over until Monday morning, and were provided with good victuals all the time by the citizens. Sunday Capt Camak permitted us to attend the churches. A portion of us went to the 1<sup>st</sup> Presbyterian church and heard a very able sermon from Dr Labou, who has recently returned from Virginia.

We arrived at Camp Cobb at 11, A.M., Monday, and after getting dinner, we spent the remainder of the day in putting up our tents. And after spending a week in drilling, the Legion was ordered to Yorktown. At half after three, Monday morning, (the 16<sup>th</sup> Sept.) we were up and preparing to leave, and about day we were on the march to the other side of Richmond, where we got aboard the York and Richmond river Railroad, where we were changed from the caes [sic] to a steamer, (the Logan). We travelled very slowly on account of the number aboard. York is a very beautiful river, it is three miles wide here. When we arrived at Yorktown it was raining, but we marched out, formed our line, and marched our camp ground. We are encamped on the field where Lord Cornwallis surrendered to Gen Washington. There is a small monument, about ten feet high, erected on the battlefield to mark the spot where Lord Cornwallis delivered up his sword. I noticed a brick house where two cannon balls had went through – one in the wall and the other through the wood near the eaves. We are using water from the yard of the house where the articles of capitulation were signed between Lord Cornwallis and Gen Washington. We have not had but one death in Cobb's Legion up to this time.

#### **Camp Cobb--16th Regiment Georgia Volunteers.**

We were much gratified by a visit yesterday to the camp, at the old Fair Ground, of the 16th Regiment of Georgia Volunteers, commanded by the Hon. Howell Cobb, President of Congress. A finer body of men, or a cleaner or better regulated camp, we have rarely seen. Although a few weeks ago a considerable number of this regiment were sick with the measles and remittent fever, we are happy to say that now, with very few exceptions, the entire strength of the regiment is lit for duty. The rapid improvement in the health of this corps is, we believe, mainly attributable to the rigid enforcement, by the Colonel and his officers, of the wise rule providing for the sick in camp, and only removing to the hospitals and private houses such cases as could not properly be attended to in the camp hospital, and to the extreme attention paid to the cooking of the soldiers' food, and the cleanliness of all parts of the camp.

During a somewhat protracted visit, we did not hear a single profane expression, nor a word which could offend the ears of the most sensitive. We found the men cheerful and happy, the officers courteous and obliging; the tents airy, scrupulously neat, and well pitched, and the general arrangements for the comfort and good order of the regiment worthy of all commendation.

We understand that the stand of colors voted by Congress at its last session to the corps commanded by its President, is now ready, and will shortly be formally presented by the President of

the Confederate States. From what we have seen of this fine body of Georgians, and from what we have heard of their moral and physical discipline, we can predict that they will prove themselves
